



# 9-Step Guide to Focusing a Landscape Photo

1

## Make all other adjustments

Frame your composition, dial in your exposure settings, and mount any filters, before you focus the shot.

2

## Consider the Depth of Field

Is your Depth of Field suitable to get the entire scene in focus from the foreground to the background?

3

## Single Point focus mode

Set the focus mode to Single Point and the focus point to small, or one step larger.

4

## Select where you want to focus

Position the focus point around one-third of the way into the scene on an element that has some contrast.

5

## Focus the camera

With Back Button Focusing set up, pressing the AF on the back of the camera to focus the shot.

6

## Check the focus

Using Live View, zoom in to the image on the back LCD screen, and check the image is in focus.

7

## Manual adjust if needed

If required, adjust the focus manually by turning the focus ring on the lens.

8

## Take the shot

Trigger the shutter with a two-second timer or remote shutter cable to minimize camera shake.

9

## Check the shot

View the shot you just took and zoom in to check if the shot is in focus.
